How will our Senators vote
on the Energy Bill giveaway?

America desperately needs a cleaner, safer energy future. But the big Energy Bill now before the U.S. Senate sends our nation backwards, offering a \$50 billion giveaway to America's worst polluters. After giving big contributions to powerful energy committee chairmen, these polluters are about to get an enormous return on their investment – at our expense.

- It lets oil companies off the hook for polluting our groundwater with the toxic fuel additive MTBE, sticking taxpayers with the \$29 billion tab for cleanup and cutting off New Hampshire's lawsuit against MTBE producers for contaminating our water supply. - It exempts oil and gas producers from the Safe Drinking Water Act when they inject diesel fuel and other harmful chemicals underground during drilling.
